BALASORE DISTRICT CE UNION IN ODISHA STATE OF NORTH INDIA:



Mazatlán Sinaloa (2) (NORTH ZONE)4. Ciudad Juárez, Chihuahua (NORTH ZONE)5. Pozole, Rosario, Sinaloa (CENTRAL ZONE)6. Apoderado, Rosario, Sinaloa (CENTRAL ZONE)7. Acaponeta, Nayarit (CENTER AREA)8. Tepic, Nayarit (CENTRAL ZONE)9. Guadalajara, Jalisco (SOUTH ZONE)10. Tlajomulco de Zúñiga, Jalisco (SOUTH ZONE)11. Ahualulco de Mercado, Jalisco (SOUTH ZONE)

The age at which young people are part of this program is between 13 to 25 or 28 years old, singles.

Secretary: Dana Jocabed Moncada Renteria


Treasurer: Nestora Rodríguez Pintado. The role is for a period of 3 years.

REPORT FROM CE in Mexico


Virtual Activities Synodal Union of CE Societies of the National Conservative Presbyterian Church of Mexico (USSEC)

On Saturday October 24 the USSEC of Mexico organized a virtual tour of emblematic places of the Protestant Reformation. Enforcers from different parts of Mexico were connected through the Zoom platform and many more followed the transmission on Facebook. We visited different parts of Germany, while the virtual guide, Jonathan Rodea, told us the story of Martin Luther.

This virtual tour was a tool to remember the biblical principles that the Reformation movement of the 16th century took up and to thank God for knowing his Word.

The USSEC also has a Whats App group, in which more than 200 enforcers from different parts of the country participate. In this group, reasons for prayer are sent, news of sick brothers is given, invitations are sent to anniversaries and activities, those who have birthday are congratulated, praise, reflections, videos are sent and the USSEC commissions organize dynamics and virtual lgames.

Every Wednesday we hold fasts and prayers. At night we connect through the Zoom platform to have a devotional time and live at a distance.



REPORT FROM CE in Germany

I want to put a huge effort into CE Germany" Harald Dürr - the new president of CE Germany.

Parts of the Interview with Harald - Questions by Stefanie Ramsperger

SR: You have been elected new president of CE Germany in October. Why did you get involved with a youth association?

HD: It is part of my self-concept to do voluntary service in my life. It is an honor for me to serve this youth association, because CE shaped me and made me the person I am today. It is one of my principles to not only receive but also give. When serving voluntarily, I never simply gave time and effort but also got back strength and encouragement.



SR: You got to know CE when you were a child. What was your best experience with CE so far? HD: I had great experience at retreats and camps where I experienced confraternity and had lots of fun. A lot of times, young people decided to live their lives with Jesus. You work for a large bank based in Frankfurt, Germany, that is known for its employees work lots and lots of over-hours.

SR: How do you manage to do both, a time-consuming job and your voluntary service?

HD: I take the time during my free leisure time. I am a night owl. That makes it easy for me to work on things after-work hours. Plus, I spent a part of my vacation with my voluntary work. This is how I did it with my prior voluntary service as president of World Vision Germany.

SR: Do you have any advice for young people to live out their Christian values at work or in school? HD: Be authentic. Don't play roles, but be who you are. Where ever you are, live out your christian principles, e.g. honesty and reliability. A "yes" must be a "yes".

SR: You have two teenage sons. Which jobs do you do you recommend them?

HD: They are eleven and twelve years old. One of them wants to me the national keeper and the other one a national soccer player. I guess, the process of occupational decision is ongoing.

SR: What branch of CE Germany's work is particularly important for you at the moment? HD: 24x-Weihnachten-neu-erleben (24 fresh experiences of Christmas) is a current topic which I am very excited about. I think it is a fantastic missionary opportunity. Apart from that the work with young people in all small and larger towns is core of CE Germany's work and as such, it is very important to me.

SR: What are your plans with CE Germany?

HD: I would like to bring my talents for Gods honor. I cannot yet tell what that means in detail. First, I must get a better picture of current challenges and questions. I want to put a huge effort into CE Germany. I want to improve things for Gods honor.

Harald Dürr is 44 years old, he is married and has two sons. Since October, he serves voluntarily as president of CE Germany. He works for a large German bank as a Wealth Manager.

For the first time, CE Germany is able to employ a head of division "Boy scouts". Christian Holfeld joined CE Germany's team in November. Christian was born in 1970 and was raised in Hamburg. When he was 13 years old he joined Boy Scouts. Prior to working for CE Germany, Christian was a professor at "Theologisches Seminar Rheinland", teaching "practical theology". His vision for his new job as head of division "boy scouts": "By Gods grace, young people get to know Jesus Christ through my work. To reach that goal, I serve my target group through modern and high-quality boy-scoutprograms. After their active time as boy scouts, young people should be strong in their relationship to Jesus and they should like to serve the congregation of their home town.

C.E. general secretary Klaus Göttler welcomed Christian: "We are happy that Christian, who is an expert in the area of boy scouting, joined our team. Since boy scouts usually meet outside, this work is specifically important in times of Covid 19. Plus, this method often speaks to young people who would otherwise not find their way to a congregation.



Christmas Event

CE Germany is a partner of the Christmas Event "24x-Weihnachten-neu-erleben". This year, the campaign will replace the live show in Karlsruhe, which will not take place as planned, due to Covid 19. The campaign offers interested churches and individuals impulses to rediscover the original meaning of Christmas. It is cross-denominational and offers video messages, ideas for sermons, material for small groups, work with children and young people as well as 24 Advent impulses for social media.
